## **HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT**

**The Health and Safety at Work Act 1974**, and its complimenting regulations, imposes statutory duties on employers and employees.

To enable these statutory duties to be carried out, it is the policy of

  - d) the working environment of all employees is safe and without risks to health, and that adequate provisions are made with regard to facilities and arrangements for their welfare at work including safe means of access to and exit from the premises
- 1. It shall be the duty of all employees at work:-
  - To take reasonable steps for the health and safety of themselves and of other persons who may be affected by their acts or omissions, required under, and incorporated in, their 'terms of employment'.

This policy will be reviewed annually.
